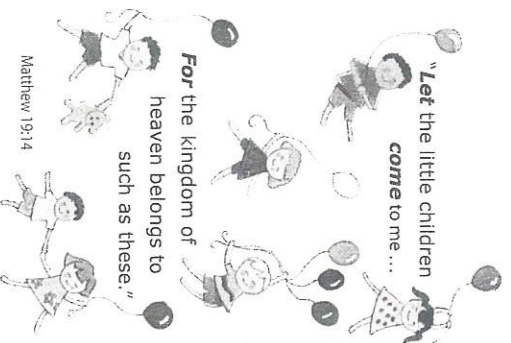


Established in 1981 to serve the young children of Broken Arrow and their families.

Program Goals

To offer children opportunities to:

Toddlers (12-23 months, by Sept. 1)

5 children: 1 teacher

*A \$40.00 non-refundable registration fee is required upon enrollment before May 18. Beginning May 19, the registration fee is \$60.00. (family maximum = \$100.00)

• Enrollment is considered to be for the entire school year, September through May. Tuition has been divided into 9 monthly payments for your convenience.
